St Fittick's Church Investigative Works: Beginning 28 July 2025, duration 6-8 weeks

Recognising the importance of this historical landmark, ETZ Ltd is working in partnership with Aberdeen City Council and Historic Environment Scotland (HES) to better understand opportunities for improvements to the condition of St Fittick's church. Site investigation works to assess the condition of the stonework beneath the concrete harling are set to begin on 28 July 2025 and will temporarily prevent access to the church. The works will be carried out with support and supervision from HES.



Planning Updates

A planning application for the first phase of proposed activity at St Fittick's Park has now been lodged with Aberdeen City Council. This proposal, called St Fittick's Park Environmental and Community Enhancements, is for the greenspace and community amenity improvements only.

This planning application includes proposals to realign East Tullos Burn, restore the wetland, extend the existing path network within the park, add new entrance features, football pitches and planting to improve biodiversity. These plans are informed by the results of the Greenspace Use Survey held online and at in-person events in Torry between late November 2024 and mid-February 2025.
